SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION

The WLD Johnson Foundation Scholarship Program is a philanthropic, leadership program that provides financial support to assist participants in meeting their educational and career goals. Any high school senior who meets the qualifications may apply for the WLD Johnson Foundation Scholarship Program and participate in the academic supports, however, scholarship dollars are limited.

The scholarship program was created to help underrepresented minority students with demonstrated financial needs with a path to college, with no need of writing dozens of essays. It focuses on broadening the number of traditionally underrepresented groups to enhance the community from which they were reared. Since 2015, the WLD Johnson Foundation has been assisting with educating and improving lives in Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas. Our organization seeks potential leaders and hopes to provide them opportunities in education through well-defined academic programs seeking to ensure exceptional workforce preparation.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a historically under represented minority, and legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico
- High school graduating senior who intends to enroll in a college or university within Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas in the Fall of the awarded year
- Students must plan to major in business, a physical science, technology, engineering, or mathematics-related discipline
- Fully complete and submit scholarship award application along with the following:
 - At least two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher/administrator or community leader attesting to your academic achievement, leadership, and character
 - Official copy of high school transcript
 - Official transcript(s) of colleges attended (including dual enrollment programs)
 - Copy of college acceptance letter(s)
- Scholarship application period: **April 17th - June 19th 2024**
- Scholarship winners will be announced on **July 1st 2024**
- Scholarships will be tendered upon proof of registration as a full-time student at a college/university.
